Dear Neighbor,

As you may know, the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development is considering a new rule under the "Housing and Community Development Act of 1980: Verification of Eligible Status," which would make individuals living in these households ineligible for federally assisted housing such as Mar Vista Gardens. If adopted, this plan could have devastating consequences for our families.

We cannot stand by while decisions made in Washington, D.C. threaten to displace or separate families who are part of our community.

However, there is an opportunity for residents to make their voices heard. Federal law requires a 60-day public comment period after the proposal is published in the Federal Register. During this time, individuals can submit comments that become part of the official record. I strongly encourage you to speak up in support of your neighbors and help ensure the voices of our most vulnerable Angelenos are heard.
